ReCharge™ supplemental watering program is a mixture of water and YUCCA™, a natural plant extract that provides needed moisture to the soil and enables your landscape to stay vibrant and healthy. The most critical time of year for ReCharge watering applications are between November and February which are traditionally the driest months in Colorado.

Lawn Care: Controlling Mites

Banks turf mites are very common in Colorado and more destructive than any other turf lawn mite.

Banks turf mite is a common mite species in Colorado, damaging drought stressed turf. It causes lawns to turn brownish yellow and straw-like often killing large areas of turf very quickly.

Banks turf mite is more destructive to lawns than other turf lawn mites. It adapts more to warm weather than the other common turf damaging mites and is usually found throughout most of the growing season.

Your best defense against mite damage is two-fold. Winter watering is your first defense. Watering your lawn during the fall, winter and early spring months, especially on the South, East and West exposures, is highly recommended when possible.

Your second defense is a mite reduction program. Swingle's mite reduction program includes three applications, beginning

in early winter and completed in late spring has proven to significantly reduce mite damage. Our mite program combined with proper watering is your best preventative from damage that may result in costly re-sodding of your lawn.

Dormant Pruning: Now's The Time

Late fall and early spring snow storms can cause extensive damage or even loss of your valuable trees and shrubs.

We recommend trimming trees and shrubs during the fall and winter months to help prepare your plant's branches from breakage during heavy or wet snow storms.

In October of 2005 an unexpected snow storm rolled through Denver and caused extensive damage and loss of trees and shrubs throughout the city. The same kind of damage can happen in the spring due to heavy wet snow storms.

Certain varieties of trees such as crabapples should only be pruned during the dormant season to prevent the spread of fireblight. The dormant season is also the perfect time to trim overgrown evergreen and spruce trees.
